ADSL T-Ball (Ages 5-7) - \$30.00 – Deadline May 1st

This is an introductory program on the basics of the game of baseball. Kids will hit off a tee and learn the fundamentals of the game and have fun!

ADSL Little League: Wood Bat League (Ages 8-10) - \$40.00 – Deadline May 15th

Participants hit with a pitching machine during all games. The machine is used 50% of the game, with the last 3 innings putting a pitcher on the mound. This enables kids to develop proper hitting techniques. Players quickly adapt defensively to this fast-paced offensive league.
